Powerful Behaviour Management

5 key principles to underpin all teaching:

- 1 Passion** – teachers and teaching assistants must be *passionate* and authoritative about teaching children to learn to read – and to enjoy reading.
- 2 Participation** – every child must be engaged throughout the lesson using direct instruction and partner teaching.
- 3 Praise** – use focused *praise* to motivate the children to want to achieve more and more.
- 4 Pace** – keep a lively *pace* so all the children stay fully engaged – there should be no down time!
- 5 Purpose** – teachers need to be clear about whether they are teaching decoding (reading), encoding (spelling) or language comprehension. Each requires a different style and method of teaching.
